View of the institution on internationalisation and mobility in particular

Bartın University, a state university officially established in 2008, has been in pursuit of quality education and research to contribute to the socio-cultural, scientific and technological development by internationalization and continued its educational activities successfully since it has been operational as part of Zonguldak Karaelmas University as well as an independent institution. As a part of this university, it successfully collaborated internationally to conduct educational and research activities for over 16 years. The University has strong policies in place to support involvement in international, especially European programmes via Forestry and Engineering Faculties. The University also has a strategy to contributing the presence and influence of academic world in Europe in order to achieve the Lisbon Goal of making the EU the most competitive knowledge-based economy, with sustainable and economic, environmental-friendly development, more and better jobs, and greater social cohesion. We strongly believe that Erasmus and other LLP actions will increase the international recognition and give opportunity to get help with subjects of quality assurance and full implementation of Bologna Process. Every department has an Erasmus coordinator who provides academic and other advice to Erasmus exchange students and closely works with the International Relations Office. Within the context of LLP program, the University will keep focusing on these priorities:

Continuous improvement of the quality of all study programs including the quality of cooperation with European institutions.

Promoting Comenius Assistantships for prospective teachers studying in various department of education

Introducing and promoting participation into Erasmus student placement and staff training

Coordinating/partnering IP, Networks projects and Leonardo tie Vinci projects

Adapt and participate new programs by focusing on the priorities set by the LLP Call for proposals.

Bartın University has strong policies to ensure that activities within the University and relations with those outside are conducted in ways that are sensitive to the ethnic, religious and social backgrounds, genders of students/staffs and to the needs of those with disabilities.
