Based on a belief in a strong and democratic European Union, the project "Y-FED: Europe is what we make of it" aims to bring the EU institutions closer to European citizens and support the localization of the European Youth Goals. This project is intended to foster and strengthen young people's active citizenship and their participation in the European project. It will contribute to raising awareness about the European Youth Policy, and will encourage policy reform and implementation actions at the local and regional levels. These aims will be achieved through an interactive process leading to a "Y-Fed: Youth simulation of the European Union". In the second part of the project, young people will enter the role of advocates for the implementation of the discussions and decisions from the simulation and advocate the implementation of the Youth Goals at the local/regional level. All the outputs from the project will be presented on a final conference with other stakeholders present. The project consortium, composed of local and European organisations representing the interests of diverse groups, will ensure that the voices of young people from different countries and socio-cultural backgrounds shape the deliverables of the project. The project partners will ensure that young people are in the driving seat through all the project and each of its phases.

COVID-19 pandemic has revealed how urban centers are the front and last lines of defense against infectious disease outbreaks. Young Service Designers' (YSD) scope is to boost hyperlocal structures for tackling local specific challenges, putting the youth at the centre of the renewal of their cities. YSD thus aims to support young people (16-21 y.o.) through a civic education and engagement approach fostering their competences and offering them the opportunity to experience a real participation in local decision-making to rethink their cities and public spaces towards healthier streets, revitalised buildings and more resilient neighbourhoods.YSD follows the methods of service design applied to the public sector. The project aims to foster engagement of youth with democratic procedures and involvement in decision making. In the first phase a training of youth workers on supporting youth to engage with democratic procedures will take place and right after a series of 7 youth exchanges with young participants from 8 European countries will be organized, aiming to enhance the ability of youth to cooperate regardless the place of origin and cultural background. Youth groups spend one week full of participatory activities and debates in 7 countries involving also local youngsters. At the end of each exchange the local youth who have been involved in the action, formulate a "local youth council". Project Summary

Background

Young people in Europe are rather social and political apathic, less involved and interested in politics in their countries and also in democratic expression as citizens. Statistics were showing that young people vote less, care less and generally have other priorities then civic participation in their countries. Media, social media, information easily found on internet usually can fuel tensions, anger and frustration of vulnerable young people which lack strong critical thinking.

Project Summary

Background

Europe has been challenged with the rise of populism and a lack of participation of Europeans. Increased political participation of young people still stands as a challenge. The EP2019 was an opportunity to reconnect young people with the European project through meaningful dialogue with decision makers and other forms of engagement. The project was realised to increase awareness about the importance of youth participation, provide educational tools and increase young voter turnout for EP2019.

Objectives

The project has succeeded in: 1. Strengthening capacities of youth organisations developing civic competences of their members, 2. The project has realised its key deliverables in three main elements: 1. capacity-building activities (Academy Skopje 2018, winter and summer training, large-scale Youth Exchanges). 2. Dissemination and campaign activities to engage young people directly (Y Vote conventions, Europe on Track workshops in 22 cities across Europe, Scout National Actions and campaign activities. 3. EP Voting Guide, project websites and collection of recommendations from young people for the future of Europe.
